

CASE REPORT: ATHEROSCLEROTIC VASCULOPATHY

The use of Medithera for the treatment of dystrophic and autoimmune skin diseases

PEMF (pulsating electromagnetic fields) have been authorized for use by the FDA and have been used in the USA since 1979 for the treatment of fractures and the consequences thereof (slight bone callus formation).

Our experience in the area of wound care and treatment has led us to turn to the Medithera system, due to the many options offered by this program. Depending on the frequency bundles in the programs "NATUR", "AKTIV" and "RELAX", we can actually exploit stimulatory effects and effects that re-establish equilibrium both in the injured tissue and the body as a whole, which we also treat with a series of nutritional additives that promote the effects of the Medithera system.

Artherosclerotic vasculopathy

75-year-old woman, blood group A+, suffering from artherosclerotic vasculopathy in the lower extremities, inadequate nutrition, chronic constipation, high blood pressure. Being treated with aggregation inhibitors, antihypertensive agents, anti-inflammatory drugs, antibiotics, antacids and drugs against anxiety.

- This disease has caused severe walking problems in the patient and trophic ulcers appeared at the beginning of the year that have spread across the entire right leg and the right foot.
- Underwent surgery to remove an iliaco-femoral obstruction and an arterial stent was inserted. In July, she was placed on a waiting list for an amputation of the extremity.

After surgical cleansing of the infected wound margins (very painful), some of which were so deep that the tendons and deep aponeuroses were being affected, the patient was then treated with topical antibiotics, adequate nutrition, diuretics for the liver and kidneys, alkalinization agents and omega 3 and 6, subcutaneous administration of heparin and nitro derivatives in the femoral region.



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After thirty days of preparation, a magnetic bioresonance therapy using the Medithera Homesystem was started.

Program "AKTIV", intensity < 3, time 32' twice daily Alternately to this

Program "NATUR", intensity > 3, time 32' twice daily

Administration of Gen-Oss, antibiotics and moist muslin bandages. Continued administration of antioxidants, alkalinization agents, omega 3 and 6 and diuretics.



Situation about three months after the start of treatment:

Very pronounced granulation and appearance of small necrotic islands. Lateral ulcer still painful and partial covering of the flexor tendons. Continuation of treatment using bioresonance Medithera programs "AKTIV" and "NATUR". Alleviation of the painful symptoms.



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Almost complete renewal of the epithelium on the leg and the skin of the foot. There are areas remaining with thin fibrin and good granulation. The lateral ulcer has almost completely disappeared.



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
